



# How to Install Overlays

First of all, please unzip the downloaded pack. On Mac, double-click the zipped file. On Windows, right-click the .zip file to select Extract All, and then follow the instructions.

## How to Install Overlays in Luminar Neo:

- Load a picture where you'd like to add an overlay.
- In Luminar Neo's top bar menu, click on the **Edit** tab.
- Click on the + button in the **Layers** menu in the left panel.
- After clicking on the + button, you'll be able to choose either from a number of default overlays or pick your own one.
- Click on **Load Images (on macOS)** or **+ (on Windows)** and select the necessary file.
- It will appear among "My images." Click on it to apply.
- To adjust the added texture/object, open the Layer Properties menu in the Tools panel; see the screenshot below. You can resize the texture/object, change its opacity, and blend mode.

To delete the unnecessary file from the list, right-click it in the "My Images" menu and choose "Remove."

## How to Install Overlays in Luminar AI:

- Load a picture where you'd like to add an overlay.
- In the top-bar menu, select the **Edit** tab.
- In the right panel, click on the Brush icon to open **Local Masking**.
- Click **+Add > Texture**.
- Choose **Texture Selection**.
- In the window that opens, select the upper menu with textures,> find Custom in the drop-down list.
- In the **Custom** section, click the + button.
- A dialog window will open where you'll need to navigate to the folder with your textures and choose the one you need.
- Confirm the selection and enjoy the tool!

If you'd like to add these textures to the default drop-down menu, click **Texture Selection > select upper menu with textures > Show Custom Textures >** copy textures to the folder that opens. Be sure to use subfolders if you'd like to organize your menu. We recommend keeping no more than 50 textures loaded at a time for better performance.
